



# Saint James School Dress Code Policy

## For All Students-

- Navy blue or khaki trousers or slacks. No cargo pants, jeggings, leggings, yoga pants or colored jeans.
- Navy blue or khaki shorts from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup>, no cargo shorts at any time. Shorts should be just above the knee.
- Ladies can also wear St. James plaid, navy blue or khaki jumpers or skirts. The length should be just above the knee. When wearing a jumper, skirt or shorts, students should solid color socks or tights. Yoga pants can be worn under a jumper or skirt.
- Long or short sleeve polo shirts, dress shirts, turtlenecks (white, navy blue or light blue) with an embroidered logo.
- Ties may be worn, but are not required, with dress shirts.
- Shirts can be untucked but must be tucked in for church, field trips and special occasions. If a shirt is tucked into pants with belt loops, a belt with a standard buckle is encouraged.
- A navy, white or gray sweater or sweater vest, **quarter zip**, fleece jacket or fleece vest with a logo can be worn indoors. Shirts do not have to have the logo on the shirt when a fleece vest, jacket or a sweater vest or jacket is worn.
- Flat shoes or sneakers must be worn each day. Sneakers cannot light up. Slippers, Flip-flops, Sandals, high heeled sneakers, wedged sneakers or wheelie sneakers cannot be worn. Boots may be worn outside but only shoes or sneakers inside the building.
- Hair should be conservatively cut. Hair should be a natural color and not impair vision.
- Students may wear small studded earrings. Body piercings are not allowed other than one pair of earrings. Makeup cannot be worn.
- Nothing should be a distraction.
- **Sweatshirts are not allowed indoors. Please wear a quarter zip, sweater or fleece with logo.**

## On Gym Days

- Students should wear their Saint James gray t-shirt, a gray Saint James sport shirt or the gray shirt from the 5K race ONLY on gym days. Eighth graders can wear their eighth grade t-shirt.
- Students can wear either navy blue or black basketball shorts, wind pants or sweatpants. NOTE: Shorts can be worn from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup> and should be just above the knee in length
- Students should carry their sneakers to gym and wear something else for the walk over.

## Middle School Perks

Middle school students (grades six, seven and eight) have additional options. Middle school students can also wear any solid colored polo or dress shirt with the embroidered logo. Students in middle school can wear small drop earrings **and natural make up**.

NOTE: Shirts can be purchased and a logo can be sewn on at Pennell Printing in Saco, A2Z Embroidery in Biddeford, or Winter People in Freeport ([www.winterpeoplesales.com/stjameschool](http://www.winterpeoplesales.com/stjameschool)). **Land's End also has clothing available (preferred school number 9000 30115)**. A patch is also available in the office.

On casual days, students can wear their choice of clothing as long as it is conservative and not offensive in any way. Tight pants or short shorts such as **yoga pants**, jeggings and leggings are never allowed. Sleeveless shirts are allowed **but** tank tops or spaghetti straps **are not**. **No holes in jeans or clothing or tattered shirts or clothing**.

We will continue to have a uniform swap at different times throughout the year. You may bring your old uniforms into school at any time. Students are expected to follow this dress code.
